Concert Attire: Concert attire is business casual to semi-formal. For example: Dress pants / polo shirt or collared shirt (with or without a tie) / (long) skirt or nice dress are all fine. We prefer no shorts/jeans/t-shirts.

Meals: Friday dinner is the only meal provided during the event. Several fast-food restaurants are within walking distance of campus.

Registration: Each student must complete our online registration form prior to January 26th. The form is located on our band website, and the link is https://register.ryzer.com/camp.cfm?ID=263697. A parent must pay the \$50 fee with a credit card when each student registers online, unless a band booster group or the school/school district is covering their fee with a group check. If this is the case, there is a check-option registration form. Students being covered by a group check *must still complete the check-option online registration form.* For a parent to pay an individual-student fee with a check, the parent must visit the McNeese band office in person (prior to January 26th). Unfortunately, we cannot accept individual checks through the mail.

Band/Chair Placement Auditions: These auditions will determine part and chair assignments within the two bands. The auditions will include:

- 2 major scales chosen from: Concert Gb, Db, Ab, Eb, Bb, F, C, G, D
- A chromatic scale
- Excerpts selected from the concert music (will be posted in mid-February)
- Sight Reading
- If you are a senior planning to major in *music education or music performance* and would like to use this as your audition for McNeese, you should bring one additional piece of music with you to perform in your audition this can be all-state audition music, an etude, a solo or anything which can display your best playing.
- If you are a senior, planning to major in something other than music at McNeese and would like to use this as your McNeese audition, you do not need to bring an additional piece of music

Percussionists will meet at 6:30 P.M. Thursday evening to audition. Keyboard and snare parts will be included in the mailing we send to your director. Percussionists must bring a variety of sticks, keyboard mallets and timpani mallets.
